CHAPTER I

INTRODUCTION

1.1 Research Background

Indonesia is developing a new curriculum called the "Merdeka curriculum." It has a program named Merdeka *Belajar Kampus Merdeka* (MBKM). This program allows students to learn through internships (Vhalery et al., 2022). After launching its internship program, University of Muhammadiyah Malang started some initiatives. One of these is the Center of Excellence (CoE) program. Its goal is to enhance the skill sets of internship sites.

CoE is a new program at the University of Muhammadiyah Malang that focuses on hard skill and soft skill training for students developed by each study program with the hope of becoming a competitive advantage as additional capital to compete in the world of global competition (Dele et al., 2024). Study programs that have CoE with specific benefits become a magnet that will provide interest to prospective new students. This program also supports the launch of the University's On-Time Graduation program to shorten students' study period. The CoE program also collaborates with other institutions, including DUDI, which is mutually beneficial. The Study Program provides new knowledge for DUDI, DUDI offers additional skills and competencies for students, and students gain networks to be able to work after graduation.
