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
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

ABSTRAK

SIKAP, PERSEPSI PENGGUNAAN DAN KEMANFAATAN ADOPSI *ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE (AI)* TERHADAP PENDIDIKAN KEPERAWATAN: SEBUAH STUDI *CROSS-SECTIONAL*

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Pendahuluan: Penggunaan Kecerdasan Buatan (AI) dalam pendidikan keperawatan terus meluas, namun penerimaannya sangat bergantung pada sikap dan persepsi mahasiswa dan dosen. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengeksplorasi bagaimana sikap, persepsi, dan manfaat yang dirasakan memengaruhi penerimaan AI dalam pendidikan keperawatan.

Tujuan: Penelitian ini menganalisis pengaruh sikap, persepsi kegunaan, dan kemudahan penggunaan terhadap minat mahasiswa keperawatan untuk mengadopsi AI di Program Studi Keperawatan Universitas Muhammadiyah Malang.

Metode: Pendekatan kuantitatif, cross-sectional digunakan, mensurvei mahasiswa keperawatan dari tahun 2021, 2022, dan 2023 di Universitas Muhammadiyah Malang (n = 241) dari total 605, dipilih melalui stratified random sampling. Data dikumpulkan menggunakan kuesioner yang di modifikasi dari penelitian terdahulu sikap, persepsi manfaat, persepsi penggunaan, dan adopsi AI diambil dari penelitian (Uly Erianti Situmorang, 2023), (Elza Lutfia Fiorentina, 2023), (Ichlasul Amal, 2023) lalu di analisa data menggunakan analisa deskriptif dan pearson.

Hasil: Sebagian besar responden berasal dari kelompok tahun 2022 (42%), di semester ke-4 (41%), dan sebagian besar adalah perempuan (89%). Analisis menunjukkan hubungan yang signifikan antara adopsi AI dan sikap, manfaat yang dirasakan, dan kemudahan penggunaan (alfa Cronbach > 0,05).

Kesimpulan: Sebagian besar mahasiswa menunjukkan sikap yang kuat terhadap adopsi AI, tetapi manfaat yang dirasakan dan kemudahan penggunaan memiliki pengaruh yang lebih rendah. Upaya pendidikan lebih lanjut direkomendasikan untuk menumbuhkan perspektif yang lebih positif terhadap adopsi AI.

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ABSTRACT

ATTITUDES, PERCEPTIONS ON THE USE AND BENEFITS OF ADOPTION ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE (AI) IN NURSING EDUCATION: A STUDY CROSS-SECTIONAL

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Introduction: *The use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in nursing education continues to expand, but its acceptance is highly dependent on the attitudes and perceptions of students and lecturers. This study aims to explore how attitudes, perceptions, and perceived benefits influence the acceptance of AI in nursing education.*

Objective: *This study analyzes the relationship between attitudes, perceived usefulness, and ease of use on nursing students' interest in adopting AI in the Nursing Study Program, University of Muhammadiyah Malang.*

Method: *A quantitative, cross-sectional approach was used, surveying nursing students from 2021, 2022, and 2023 at University of Muhammadiyah Malang (n = 241) from a total of 605, selected through stratified random sampling. Data were collected using a questionnaire modified from previous studies of attitudes, perceived benefits, perceived use, and adoption of AI taken from research (Uly Erianti Situmorang, 2023), (Elza Lutfia Fiorentina, 2023), (Ichlasul Amal, 2023) then analyzed the data using descriptive and Pearson analysis.*

Results: *Most respondents came from the 2022 cohort (42%), in the 4th semester (41%), and most were female (89%). The analysis showed a significant relationship between AI adoption and attitudes, perceived benefits, and ease of use (Cronbach's alpha > 0.05).*

Conclusion: *Most students showed strong attitudes towards AI adoption, but perceived benefits and ease of use had a lower influence. Further educational efforts are recommended to foster a more positive perspective on AI adoption.*

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

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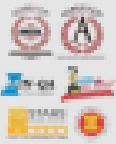
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
